# Staff Report

- **SUBJECT:** Consider Appointment of Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officers
- **CEQA**: This action does not constitute a "project" as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines section 15378 as it is an administrative activity of the City that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

### Recommendation

Appoint two applicants to fill two of three vacancies for Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officer.

### Background

The role of Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officer was established in Del Rey Oaks Municipal Code Title 1, Article 4. Article 4 states, in part:

ARTICLE 4. - ADMINISTRATIVE ENFORCEMENT HEARING OFFICERS

1.19.370 - Designated of administrative hearing officers.

A. The City shall have three volunteer Administrate Enforcement Hearing Officers, which shall consist of three residents of the City, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the council. The Hearing Officers shall:

- 1. Conduct all administrative and appeal hearings authorized by this Code or by any City ordinance;
- 2. Authorize the imposition of liens, assessments, special collection, or other collection process against a responsible party and any affected property, as appropriate; and
- 3. Perform such other programs or functions related to administrative hearings and appeals that the City Council or the City Manager may, from time to time, authorize or request.

C. Hearing officer panel terms of office. Each appointee to the Hearing Officer panel shall serve for a two-year term; provided, however, that two members of the panel shall be appointed to terms ending on January 31 in even-numbered years, and one member of the panel shall be appointed to terms ending on January 31 in odd-numbered years. Any

vacancy on the Hearing Officer panel shall be filled for the unexpired remainder of that term, pursuant to the process described in subsection (A) above.

#### Summary & Discussion

Currently, all three Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officer positions are vacant. After several open recruitment terms, the City has received two applications from previous Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officers; Paul Peterlin and Fredrica Jones. Mr. Peterlin's previous term expired on January 31, 2022. Ms. Jones' term expired on January 31, 2023. The current appointments will be for the term of February 1, 2023 through January 31, 2025.
