SUBJECT:	Retroactive Salary Schedule for Fiscal Year 2021-22

# **Discussion**

CalPERS recently conducted a compensation review of former Police Chief Jeffrey Hoyne for the period of 10/01/2018 - 12/16/2022. Staff was able to provide all the requested information with one exception. Staff was not able to find a Council approved salary schedule that had his correct salary as reported to CalPERS.

On August 24, 2021 Council approved a new contract with a salary increase for Jeffrey Hoyne, former Chief of Police, as part of his performance review in closed session. It appears the Salary Schedule was not updated at that time. CalPERS recommends that the City approve a Retroactive Salary Schedule for Fiscal Year 2021-2202 to correct the Monthly pay rate to \$14,333.33 and an Hourly Pay Rate of \$82.69 to validate the pay rates for Jeffrey Hoyne.

Without the retroactive salary schedule, CaIPERS will use the hourly rate of \$80.29 which matches the provided Publicly Available Pay Schedule, until a Council approved publicly available pay schedule is provided. In other words, in order for former Chief Hoyne to receive retirement credit for his reported earnings, the Council needs to approve the attached Retroactive Salary Schedule for FY 2021-22.

## **Recommendation**

Approve the retroactive salary resolution. The only difference between the retroactive salary resolution and the original salary resolution approved for FY 21-22 is the salary for the Chief of Police.

### Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact from this approval. This action serves to satisfy the CalPERS requirement of having all paid wages in a Publicly Available Pay Schedule.
