- 17 Mayor Niles called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. Mayor Niles conducted a roll call. Council Members
- 18 Killpack, Banks, and Chase were present. Council Members Western and Bunker were absent.

19 Official Canvass Election Results

- 20 City Recorder Sherri Westbrook reported on the results of the November 21, 2023 General Election.
- 21 She reported that Delta City contracted with Millard County for the handling of the 2023 elections. Delta
- 22 has 1564 registered voters. There were 794 ballots cast for the election resulting in a 50.77% voter
- turnout. There were 22 challenged ballots and of those 22 votes, two were received after the deadline
- 24 and were not counted, thirteen of the voters contacted did not respond or provide the necessary
- 25 identification, and nine were verified and signed. 7 votes did not contain the affidavit. The official results
- 23 Identification, and fille were verified and signed. 7 votes did not contain the amdavit. The official results
- were Nick Killpack, 426 votes; Kelly Carter, 602 votes; Brett Clyde Bunker, 344 votes; KC Bogue, 516
- 27 votes. The elected council members were Nick Killpack, Kelly Carter and KC Bogue. Council Members
- 28 Banks, Chase, and Killpack signed the Certification of Election.
- 29 Council Member Kiley Chase MOVED to accept the election canvass as it has been presented. The motion
- 30 was SECONDED by Council Member Banks. Mayor Niles asked if there were any questions or comments
- 31 regarding the motion. There being none, he called for a vote. The motion passed with Council Member
- 32 Killpack, Council Member Banks and Council Member Chase in favor.
- 33 Council Members Western and Bunker were absent.
