On January 5, 2023, the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (CIB) had its first review Delta City's application for \$7,387,000 (a \$3,694,000 30 yr. @ 1% loan and a \$3,693,000 grant) to help finance the Wastewater Improvements 2022.

Following the project sponsors' presentation, the CIB voted to advance the application \$7,387,000 (a \$4,950,000 30 yr. @ 1.5% loan and a \$2,437,000 grant) to the *Priority List* for prioritization and funding consideration at the February 2, 2023 CIB board meeting

Please be advised that placement on the *Priority List* does not in and of itself constitute formal approval or commitment to finance this application in the amounts or terms listed above. The size, nature and timing requirements of all applications advanced to the *Priority List*, as well as the actual availability of funds may require the CIB to alter or reduce its participation from the amounts or terms requested for this project.

You will receive copies of the agenda approximately 10 - 14 days in advance of the February 2, 2023 CIB board meeting confirming a slot on the agenda. While no formal presentations will be heard from the various applicants, you or your representative should plan on attending this meeting to answer any questions raised by the individual CIB members.
