### **BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:**

The Public Health Advisory Board (PHAB) leadership will introduce themselves to the Board for the purpose of opening the door for more dialogue between the BOCC and the PHAB in the future.

Following the introductions, PHAB Member Sarah Baron will provide an update on the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds awarded by the Board to Central Oregon Community College (COCC). The presentation will describe the progress made to expand the public health workforce using various strategies:

- Outreach efforts and campaigns to promote public health careers in high schools, colleges, and the community at large;
- Training, scholarships, and paid practicums (e.g., access to housing assistance, food resources and childcare, as well as potential employment opportunities); and
- Collaborative efforts to leverage Medicaid and State funds to sustain community health outreach efforts and workforce development.
