ORDER NO. 2026-003

WHEREAS, Certain companies holding County franchises to collect commingled recyclables within specific unincorporated areas of Deschutes County, Oregon have requested a collection rate for offering Commingled Recycling service in the “Distant Rural” collection zones in accordance with County policy; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Solid Waste and the County Administrator have reviewed the rate request and made recommendations regarding rates and services; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on February 11, 2026 on the proposed fee adjustments and has reviewed the proposed adjustments and the Director of Solid Waste’s recommendation; now, therefore,

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DESCHUTES COUNTY, OREGON, HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

Section 1. The maximum rates for bi-weekly Commingled Recycling collection service in any of the unincorporated area of Deschutes County designated as the Distant Rural Collection Area served by Republic Services will be no greater than \$6 per month.

Section 2. If approved, Republic Services will submit a formal request to approve commencement of universal Commingled Recycling service in coordination with any new rate adjustments for FY 2027, effective after July 1, 2026 upon delivery of collection carts and commencement of services.

Section 3. Department of Solid Waste staff will submit to the Board of County Commissioners all formal requests from Republic Service for final approval.
