SUBJECT: Approval of Document No. 2026-0031, a Notice of Intent to Award Contract for the Supply and Hauling of Crushed, Uncoated Rock for Chip Seal 2026

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Document No. 2026-0031.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Deschutes County Road Department prepared bid solicitation documents for the Supply and Hauling of Crushed, Uncoated Rock for Chip Seal 2026. The project scope of work includes furnishing and delivery of aggregate material to specified stockpiles in the Redmond and Bend Maintenance Zones. The project was advertised in the *Daily Journal of Commerce* on January 16, 2026. The Department opened bids at 2:00 P.M. on January 28, 2026.

Two (2) bids were received for this project. The bid results are as follows:

| Engineer's Estimate | \$469,800.00 |

This action issues a Notice of Intent to Award the contract to the apparent low bidder, Knife River Corporation - Northwest, and allows seven days for concerned parties to protest the award. If there is no protest within the seven-day period, the contract will be awarded to the apparent low bidder. The bid tabulation, including the Engineer's estimate, is attached.

BUDGET IMPACTS:

The expenditure is budgeted in the Road Fund (325) for Fiscal Year 2026.
