SUBJECT: Consideration of Document No. 2022-086, an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the US20 at Tumalo Multi-Use Trail Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Document No. 2022-086.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

During development of the US20: Tumalo – Cooley Rd project, Deschutes County and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) identified the opportunity to address bicycle and pedestrian safety in the Tumalo Unincorporated Community by way of a multi-use path connecting 4th Street on the north side of US20 to Bailey Road on the south side of US20; the multi-use path will cross under US20 north of the intersection with 5th Street with an undercrossing structure. ODOT identified state funding to construct the undercrossing structure, and construction of the undercrossing structure was added to the scope of the US20: Tumalo – Cooley Rd project.

This agreement will provide for the construction of the multi-use path connecting the undercrossing structure to 4th Street and Bailey Road. The project will also include the improvement of 4th Street between Bruce Avenue and Wood Avenue to provide for pedestrian and bicycle connectivity between Cook Avenue and the multi-use path. The project will be delivered by ODOT and is anticipated to be let for construction bids in April 2023 and completed by December 31, 2023. The project is anticipated to be constructed simultaneously with the US20: Tumalo – Cooley Rd project.

BUDGET IMPACTS:

The estimate project cost is \$1,200,000. The project cost is included in the Road Capital Improvement Plan (Road CIP, Fund 465) budget for Fiscal Year 2022.
