SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution No. 2026-011, adopting the Deschutes County Transportation Safety Action Plan

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Resolution No. 2026-011.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Deschutes County Road Department has completed an update to the Deschutes County Transportation Safety Action Plan (TSAP). The current Deschutes County TSAP was completed in 2019. This TSAP update was funded by the United States Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program. The TSAP includes:

- a network screening of crash data on the County road network for the study period of 2018 through 2022;
- a determination of primary crash types, causes, and locations; and
- mitigation measures to reduce and eliminate fatal and serious injury crashes, including site-specific road improvement projects, systemic road safety countermeasures, and enforcement and education strategies for the County and community partners.

At the March 18th meeting, Road Department staff will give a presentation of the TSAP. Upon conclusion of the presentation, the Board of County Commissioners will consider approving Resolution No. 2026-011 to formally adopt the Deschutes County TSAP.
