<u>SUBJECT</u>: Contract for School-Based Health Center at Bend High School

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Board signature of Document No. 2023-563, a contract with Bend-La Pine Schools and Mosaic Community Health for a school-based health center at Bend High.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The Deschutes County School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs) offer affordable, convenient health care and health education to children and their parents or guardians who live in the Bend-La Pine, Redmond, or Sisters school districts. The purpose of the SBHCs is to support and achieve improved health management for students and their families. SBHCs operate as a collaboration between the County, School District and a medical sponsor. This contract serves as an understanding of this collaboration and outlines the roles and responsibilities of each party in providing these services.

Mosaic Community Health serves as the medical sponsor for the Bend High School-Based Health Center. Mosaic offers well child exams and sick child exams within the scope of practice of a pediatric nurse practitioner or family nurse practitioner and submits claims to the applicable health plans. Mosaic also provides Behavioral Health Consultant Services to help support the needs of the SBHC.
