BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DESCHUTES COUNTY, OREGON, ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE RURAL LAW ENFORCEMENT DISTRICT (DISTRICT 2), as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Board of County Commissioners of Deschutes County, Oregon, acting as the governing body of the Rural Law Enforcement District (District 2), hereby adopts the budget for fiscal year 2026 in the total sum of \$22,342,000. A copy of this budget document is currently available in the office of the Deschutes County Board of County Commissioners.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Board of County Commissioners of Deschutes County, Oregon, acting as the governing body of the Rural Law Enforcement District (District 2), hereby imposes the ad valorem property taxes provided for in the fiscal year 2026 adopted budget at the tax rate of \$1.5500 per \$1,000 of assessed value for operations; and that these taxes are hereby imposed and categorized for tax year 2025-26 upon the assessed value of all taxable property within the district as follows:
