SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING - Consideration of Order No 2022-005, Surrendering Jurisdiction of Portions of NW Pershall Way, NW 10th Street, and SW Helmholtz

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Order No. 2022-005.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

With City of Redmond Resolution No. 2021-36, the City of Redmond has requested jurisdiction of portions of NW Pershall Way, NW 10th Street, and SW Helmholtz Way. Upon a public hearing for the matter, the Board of County Commissioners will consider adoption of Order No. 2022-005, which will surrender jurisdiction of the subject road segments to the City of Redmond.

BUDGET IMPACTS:

Jurisdictional transfer of the subject road segments will remove approximately 0.26 mile of road from the County road inventory. This will result in a very minimal reduction to the Department's operation and maintenance expenditures.
