RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Chair signature of document #2022-550, an Oregon Health Authority agreement #169509-9

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The State of Oregon, through its Oregon Health Authority (OHA), and Deschutes County adopted the 2021-23 Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA), #169509 for the Financing of Public Health Services effective July 1, 2021. The IGA outlined the program descriptions, funding, and reporting requirements for Deschutes County's Public Health Division. The individual public health program elements (PE) represented in this Intergovernmental Agreement include disease prevention services, Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) services, School Based Health Centers (SBHC), the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program, public health emergency preparedness, the Safe Drinking Water Program, tobacco, alcohol, drug and suicide prevention services, and family planning. Each PE has a set of program description, operational and reporting requirements.

This amendment #9 restates the original IGA between the Oregon Health Authority and Deschutes County and outlines funding, totaling \$4,058,424.38, for fiscal year 2023. Funding included in this amendment is \$26,946.67 greater than total funding for fiscal year 21-22 and does not including funding for PE 43-01, Public Health Practice - Immunization Services (\$49,756 for FY 21-22) and PE 46-05 or RH Community Participation and Assurance of Access (\$29,982 for FY 21-22). These PEs will be funded in forthcoming amendments.
