Two Draft Board Orders

- Not land use
- General approach: for consistency, develop a program very similar to Bend and Redmond's programs
- Board Order 2023-052: within an Urban Growth Boundary
- Board Order 2023-053: within one-mile of an Urban Growth Boundary

Board Order 2023–052 (within UGB)

City of Bend UGB - Overnight Camping

- Up to 3 vehicles
- Property owner: business, non-profit, public agency
- Access to sanitation, including bathroom, hand washing, and trash disposal facilities
- No fee may be required for overnight stays



Board Order 2023–052 (within UGB)

City of Bend UGB - Transitional Overnight Parking

- Plan for access to bathroom, hand washing, trash disposal, case management/supervision*
- Notification to neighbors*
- Up to six vehicles and/or temporary huts/tents
 - Public entities may allow more than 6 vehicles or huts/tents

(* indicates item is not required for overnight camping category)

Board Order 2023–052 (within UGB)

City of Redmond UGB

- Up to 6 vehicles; vehicles only
- Plan for access to bathroom, hand washing, trash disposal, case management/supervision
- Allowed at religious institutions, non-profits, public agencies, commercial property.
- Not allowed on residential property



Board Order 2023–053 (outside UGB)

Within 1- mile of UGB

City of Bend

- Only vehicles
- Zones: MUA-10, Public Facility, RC, RI, RR-10

City of Redmond

- Only vehicles
- Zones: MUA-10, RI, RR-10
