SUBJECT: Consideration of Document No. 2022-119, a Notice of Intent to Award Contract for the Supplying and Hauling of Crushed Pre-Coated and Uncoated Rock for Chip Seal 2022

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Document No. 2022-119.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The Road Department prepared bidding documents for the Supplying and Hauling of Crushed Pre-Coated and Uncoated Rock for Chip Seal 2022. The work under this contract will include processing of aggregate materials and delivery of processed materials to designated stockpile locations throughout the County for chip sealing operations in Calendar Year 2022. The bid solicitation was advertised in the *Daily Journal of Commerce* and *The Bulletin* on January 12 and 19, 2022. The Department opened bids on January 26, 2022.

Two (2) bids were received. The bid results are as follows:

High Desert Aggregate and Paving, Inc.	\$ 661,225.00
Knife River Corporation - Northwest	\$ 764,490.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 698,600.00

This action issues a Notice of Intent to Award the contract to the apparent low bidder, High Desert Aggregate and Paving, Inc., and allows seven days for concerned parties to protest the award. If there is no protest within the seven-day period, the contract will be awarded to the apparent low bidder. The bid tabulation, including the Engineer's estimate, is attached.

BUDGET IMPACTS:

A portion of the material cost is budgeted in the Road (Fund 325) budget for Fiscal Year 2022; the remaining portion of the material cost will be budgeted in the Road (Fund 325) budget for Fiscal Year 2023.
