SUBJECT: Consideration of Purchase Agreement, Document No. 2025-979 and Dedication

Deed, Document No. 2025-980 from the Pettit Family Trust for Right of Way for

the Tumalo Reservoir Road Improvement Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval of Purchase Agreement (Document No. 2025-979) and Dedication Deed (Document No. 2025-980), with the Pettit Family Trust for Right of Way for the Tumalo Reservoir Road Improvement Project

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

The Board of County Commissioners authorized the Road Department to negotiate with owners of properties impacted by the Tumalo Reservoir Road Improvement project for the acquisition of right of way by Resolution No. 2025-035. During preliminary design of the project, it was determined that a portion of Tax Lot No. 1611330001601, owned by the Pettit Family Trust, would be impacted by the Project. The Road Department has negotiated with the property owner for right of way acquisition. The property owner has agreed to the following:

Instrument: Dedication Deed

Area: ± 406 sq. ft. (± 0.01 acre)

Compensation: \$2,000.00 Other Consideration: None

BUDGET IMPACTS:

The County will make payment to the property owner in the amount of \$2,000.00, which is budgeted in the Department's Fiscal Year 2026 Road Capital Improvement Plan (Fund 465) budget.
