SUBJECT: Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) Term Expirations and Reappointments

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Direct staff to either:

1. Reappoint the three at-large BPAC members who have requested to be reappointed (to be done at a later date via consent agenda) and initiate recruitment for one at-large vacancy; or
2. Initiate recruitments for all four at-large BPAC members.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Staff is requesting Board direction concerning BPAC reappointments. Six of the thirteen members of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)'s terms are due to expire at the end of June. Two of these are represented by the cities of Bend and Sisters and have a separate process. All at-large members except one have requested reappointment. Historically, the Board has chosen to reappoint members requesting to do so, but they may choose to pursue a different process as this is at the Board's discretion.
