SUBJECT: Consideration of Board approval and Chair signature of Amendment 8 to OHA #166040, Document #2022-077.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Move approval and Chair signature of Amendment #8 to OHA #166040, Document #2022-077.

BACKGROUND AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Intergovernmental Agreement #166040 amendment, #8, provides returned funding in the amount of \$253,071 for Service Element #25, Crisis Services for the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

In 2019 and 2020, the Deschutes County Board of Commissioners approved the signing of Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) #159163-4 and #159163-15 outlining the services and financing of Community Mental Health, Addiction Treatment, Recovery & Prevention, and Problem Gambling Services for the 2019-2021 fiscal years. In these specific amendments, OHA reduced service element funding for the purpose of extending the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) demonstration permitted by the State's Medicaid Plan for the CCBHC.

A total of \$1,360,796 was reduced from the IGAs across several service elements. The unused funds, \$253,071, are being returned to Deschutes County through the Crisis Services service element (MHS #25).
