City Manager's Report:

- 1. <u>Makiki Drive</u> The contractor has installed the conflict box and the sewer line. The concreate drainage line is being installed up to the water line. Once he has all parts and equipment needed to install the steel casing around the water line, he will perform this part of the project. The contractor has requested a time extension which is being reviewed by the engineering firm. The road will continue to be closed until the work is complete. The current end date for the contract is January 09, 2023.
- 2. <u>Hilo Way</u> The engineering firm has issued a notice to proceed for 01/16/2023. The contract is for 120 days with a current substantial completion date set for May 16, 2023.
- 3. <u>Traffic Study</u> The Golf Club Drive section of the study has been performed and design options have been developed. The city is currently reviewing the options and will provide a presentation to the council at the next meeting.
- 4. <u>Phase 4 paving</u> The paving project is currently demobilized until the area around Bayou Circle is available to complete the project. The current end date of the project is February 15th.
- 5. <u>Park Ten Road</u> The City and engineering firm has adjusted the small section between Leisure Time Road and the Park Ten Lanes. This part of the road will be 10' wide with a 1' gutter. This will match the rest of the road from Leisure Time to Noma Circle. The northern sidewalk will be reduced to 8 feet.
- 6. <u>Stormwater Master Plan</u> The City and the engineering firm met again today to finalize plans to address the ditches and stormwater flow within the city.
- 7. <u>Twin Lakes Park / Dog Park</u> The engineer for the Twin Lakes Park and dog park is here to discuss the project.

Jerrod Kilpatrick with Mahado Patano Design Group discussed the Twin Lakes/Dog Park Project.
