RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REQUEST TO THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR SECTION 592 ENVIRONMENTAL INFRASTRUCTURE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FUNDING FOR FLOOD PREVENTION AND REDUCTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS THROUGH CRITICAL STORMWATER, WATER AND SEWER REPAIRS, COMMITTING MATCHING FUNDS AND FOR OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Diamondhead (the "City") has identified a need for flood damage prevention and reduction of environmental impacts through critical stormwater, water and sewer infrastructure repairs; and

WHEREAS, the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is accepting proposals for new and modified project authorizations for Section 592 Environmental Infrastructure Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to submit a proposal to the USACE to be considered for project authorization through Section 592 Environmental Infrastructure Assistance Program fund in the amount of \$1,600,000 (federal funds) to address critical infrastructure needs in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City, if awarded \$1,600,000 for such critical infrastructure needs through the program, would be required to provide 25% or \$400,000 match funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF DIAMONDHEAD, MISSISSIPPI, THAT:

SECTION ONE: The statements, findings, determinations, and conclusions contained in the preamble of this resolution are hereby adopted, ratified and incorporated therein.

SECTION TWO: The City Manager, is hereby authorized to submit a proposal to the USACE to be considered for project authorization through Section 592 Environmental Infrastructure Assistance Program fund in the amount of \$1,600,000 (federal funds) to address critical infrastructure needs in the City.

SECTION THREE: The City of Diamondhead hereby commits match funding in the amount of 25% or \$400,000 to the project should the proposal to address critical infrastructure needs in the accepted receive funding through the USACE Section 592 Environmental Infrastructure Assistance Program.

SECTION FOUR: The City Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution and to provide any information to the United Sates Army Corps of Engineers in order to complete its review and consideration of the proposal submitted.

SECTION FIVE: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after adoption.
