PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN DIAMONDHEAD, MS AND TETRA TECH, INC. FOR DISASTER DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES

AMENDMENT NO. 1

2024 Request for Contract Renewal and Rate Change

Dear Ms. Klein,

The City of Diamondhead, MS entered into a contract for Disaster Debris Monitoring Services with Tetra Tech, Inc. (Tetra Tech) for a period beginning on August 18, 2021 through August 18, 2024 with the option to renew the contract term for up to two (2) additional one (1) year periods. Tetra Tech is requesting the City of Diamondhead, MS to exercise the first renewal option from August 19, 2024 to August 18, 2025 with an adjustment to the hourly rates based on the CPI-U Base Price Adjustment Calculation below:

<u>CPI for May 2023:</u> 295.889 <u>CPI for May 2024:</u> 305.296

<u>Increase Calculation:</u> 305.296 (May 2024) - 295.889 (May 2023) = 9.407

9.407 / 295.889 (May 2023) = 3.18% increase

As such, Tetra Tech requests the City of Diamondhead, MS to consider increasing Tetra Tech's hourly rates by 3.18%. Please find enclosed the updated hourly rates for review and approval which includes the 3.18% increase (Attachment A) and a detailed calculation breakdown as well as the CPI-U Original Data Value for May 2023 to May 2024 (Attachment B).
