RESOLUTION NO. 2024-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS TO PURCHASE A COMPACT TRACK LOADER (SKID STEER) FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, for regular operations the street department utilizes a skid steer for streets, sidewalk and bike path maintenance: and

WHEREAS, an additional skid steer is needed to effectively maintain City of Dillingham infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a new skid steer coming from Anchorage is available from one source; and

WHEREAS, if a new skid steer is purchased the City is asking to waive the purchasing restrictions based on the criteria outlined in DMC 4.30.130, Exemptions A. 3, To supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services which can only be furnished by a single dealer, or which have a uniform published price, and Exemption; and

WHEREAS, prices were checked from multiple dealers. The Bobcat brand skid steer from Craig Taylor Equipment Co, is the lowest price and best fit for City of Dillingham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Dillingham City Council waives the purchasing restrictions as stated above to purchase a skid steer in an amount not to exceed \$100,000;

PASSED and ADOPTED by a duly constituted quorum of the Dillingham City Council on September 5, 2024.
