I want to thank the library staff for faithfully being there at the library to serve the patrons of our community. Everyone works diligently to keep the doors open during the scheduled library hours each day. Our newest Librarian Assistant, Helen Nelson, has been doing an excellent job during her first month of work. She takes initiative and is always asking questions to learn her job well and to be a team player.

At the time of writing this report, I'm in Colorado helping to care for my elderly mother (April 17 – May 16). I'm working remotely with the staff & city insuring projects, grants, budgets, and daily activies requiring my supervision are carried on for the library.

Department Accomplishment and Opportunities:

Our Librarian Aide, Jonas Tweet, travelled to Japan with his high school group last month. He was also able to attend Regions for Band in Unalakleet in April. Our youth here in Dillingham have many opportunies to grow and learn from; working a part-time job while attending high school is one more of these awesome experiences.

Everyone, including our newest employee, was able to complete the APEI training for the City by the April 15th deadline and received 8 hours of paid leave for doing so. The courses completed were the following: Absorbents and Spills, Business Writing Basics, Back Injuries, Defensive Driving Basics, Developing Effective Communications Skills, and Sexual Harassment in the Workplace.
