24 EMS calls

2 fire related calls

Fire/EMS activity:

- Testing for volunteers Scott Pak re-scheduled for summer
- Scott Pak service will be performed this summer
- EMS/prevention participated in Children's fair hosted by BBNA and the hospital
- Completed a new Infectious control policy that has been sent to the lawyer for review
- Summer EMTs (Emergency Medical Technician) positions have been filled 3 out of town, and 3 locals, starting the end of May
 - Partial funding will come from BBEDC
- Eng 1 and tanker 5 will be worked on by an outside vendor at the beginning of May 8th
- We have 5 new certified EMTs
- Due to the process of catching up on maintenance and certification we are working on budget revisions
- The four-day fire training was very successful. Trainers from the Fairbanks fire department came and went over fire ground tactics and safety procedures
- The fire department is in the pre-planning stages of producing a long-term plan for a new fire station. Decisions need to be made by the city manager and planning for direction
- We have had some serious snow-go events and will be working on prevention and safety training for these types of events
- Developing Narcan training for the harbor, OBI and Peter Pan for their summer workers
- In the beginning process of specking out new fire truck to replace Eng 4. This is a 3-year process
