WHEREAS, the 2022 Statewide Clean Boating Survey and Outreach Report incorporated needs from both entities with end result of additional signage to be displayed in and around the Dillingham Boat Harbor, and

WHEREAS, the report covered the Dillingham Boat Harbor in the sampling of water in the Harbor waters in participation of the report, and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Boat Harbor Port Director has pledged participation in the Alaska Clean Harbors Program, and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Port Director was very active in the participating of the survey, assisting with the each step of the survey and final steps of the report, and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Port Director had pledged the City of Dillingham Boat Harbor to the Clean Harbor Program participation, and

WHEREAS, a final step in the process was to involve the Dillingham City School District in a drawing contest with the chosen drawing to be part of the informational signage to be displayed,
