Section 2. Amendment to Subsection A of Section 2.09.080. Dillingham Municipal Code Section 2.09.080 subsection A is hereby amended to read as follows [new language <u>underlined and emboldened</u> and deleted text displayed in <u>strike out font</u>]:

2.09.080 Order of business

- A. The order of business for the regular meetings of the city council shall be as follows:
 - 1. Call to order;
 - 2. Roll call;
 - 3. Approval of minutes;
 - 4. Approval of consent calendar and regular agenda;
 - 5. Staff reports;
 - a. Strategic plan report,
 - b. City manager and staff reports,
 - Standing committee reports;
 - 6. Public hearings;
 - 7. Citizens' **comments** discussion (prior notice or agenda items);
 - 8. Ordinances and resolutions;
 - 9. Unfinished business:

10. New business;
11. Citizens comments discussion (open to public);
12. Council discussion;
13. Mayor's discussion;
14. Adjournment.
Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
