## CALL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Dillingham City Council was held on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, at the Dillingham City Council Chambers and via video conferencing, in Dillingham, Alaska. Mayor Ruby called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

been discussed that should not have been discussed on a public platform nor on record. Will there be any sort of "retaliation" against him?

 Megan McCambly, not representing the DCSD, expressed support for Tracy O'Malley as Chief of Police. She believes Tracy has the needed experience for this position.
