Wanted to provide you with an update on the funding status in support of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) maintenance dredging of Dillingham Harbor.

The President's Budget for fiscal year 2027 (FY27) was released on 3-Apr-2026. You can access the USACE FY27 Civil Works Press Book using the following link:

The FY27 President’s Budget reflects USACE capabilities and priorities for executing the Civil Works program. The current budget prioritizes limited resources towards core mission areas, with a strong emphasis on completing ongoing projects. While the FY27 budget does not include funding for Dillingham Harbor, we are continuing to perform the 2026 maintenance dredging under the recently awarded contract using the funds on hand.
