RESOLUTION NO. 2024-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A COMPACT TRACK LOADER (SKID STEER) FOR THE STREET DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, for regular operations the street department utilizes a skid steer for streets, sidewalk and bike path maintenance; and

WHEREAS, an additional skid steer is needed to effectively maintain City of Dillingham infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that a new skid steer coming from Anchorage is available from one source; and

WHEREAS, prices were checked from multiple dealers through SourceWell, a procurement process that researches bids; and

WHEREAS, SourceWell found that the Bobcat brand skid steer from Craig Taylor Equipment Co, is the lowest price and also the best fit for City of Dillingham.

WHEREAS, the budget effective July 1st 2024 authorized \$120,000 for the purchase of a skid steer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Dillingham City Council authorizes the purchasing of a skid steer in an amount not to exceed \$100,000;

PASSED and ADOPTED by a duly constituted quorum of the Dillingham City Council on September 12, 2024.
