## **STAFF REPORT**

During the month of July, the Senior Center served 505 home delivered meals to 38 individuals. Our ride service is still suspended at this time.

Ocean Beauty Seafoods donated a large amount of frozen food to the Senior Center, valued at over \$22,000. The majority of it will be used for the Center directly. Items we did not have room to store was distributed directly to our elders. Many elders were able to make use of the items.

We had planned to start our ride service again beginning here in August, but with COVID hitting our region again and numbers rising again, we will postpone restarting ride service until it passes some. We will continue to deliver and prepare lunches for pickup.
