Our current library hours are:

Open Tuesday and Wednesday from 12 noon until 4 pm
Friday from 10 am to 6 pm
Saturday from 10 am to 2 pm
Closed on Sunday, Monday, and Thursday

We are planning our Summer Reading Program to be held on Fridays from 10:30 am to 12 noon. Two age groups (3-6 and 7-11), along with a possible teen group (ages 12 and up) will enjoy fun activities with prizes and awards to encourage and reward their reading progress throughout the summer.
