STAFF REPORT

During the month of April, the Senior Center served 616 home delivered meals to 56 individuals. Our ride service is still suspended at this time.

BBNA Food Bank has donated dry goods to the Senior Center again this year. They have been very helpful, shipping out dry good to our elders in the surrounding villages. They even able to send out fresh produce for the elders.

We are still continuing to deliver lunches and pick-ups. I am hopeful that we will be able to reopen for normal services in August. We will look at the situation over the summer and make a decision in July. I know the elders do miss coming to eat and visit at the Senior Center. We will have good safety plans in place for reopening so that we can keep our elders as safe as possible. We may start small and then increase the number of people at the Center. It depends on the situation in the fall and what the current City ordinances are at that time.
