A RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION HONORING JOHN MARX FOR HIS YEARS OF

WHEREAS, John Marx began his service with the City of Dillingham on January 4, 1999, as a Non-Secure Shelter Attendant for the Dillingham Police Department in a temporary position; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2000, John Marx began service in emergency communications as Dispatcher Level II B; and

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2003, John Marx was appointed Acting Dispatch Supervisor and was promoted to Dispatch Supervisor on March 29, 2004; and

WHEREAS, John Marx resigned from City service on July 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, John Marx began volunteering with the Volunteer Fire Department and EMS beginning in 2006 and continued to do so for the next sixteen years; and

WHEREAS, John Marx returned to City service on May 28, 2015, when he was rehired as Dispatch II; and

WHEREAS, John Marx served as Acting Dispatch Supervisor from June 6, 2021 through June 14, 2021, returned to Dispatch II on June 15, 2021, and was promoted to Dispatch Supervisor on September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, John Marx has provided more than eighteen (18) years of active service to the City of Dillingham, demonstrating professionalism, dedication, and a strong commitment to public safety; and

WHEREAS, John Marx will retire effective January 19, 2026, marking the conclusion of a distinguished career in public service to the City of Dillingham;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DILLINGHAM that the City of Dillingham hereby expresses its sincere appreciation and gratitude to John Marx for his faithful and dedicated service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council extends its best wishes to John Marx for a happy and fulfilling retirement.
