#### Public Safety Impact

The use of mapped streets for this event causes little or no issues of concern for Public Safety, due to the precautions listed throughout the application.

#### Traffic Movement

Parking - will be restricted in permitted area.

Travel - Open to vehicular traffic except for the 100 block of West Merrimac Street, the 100 block of West Chapel Street and the 200 block of North Main Street.

Access by Businesses/Residents Open to pedestrian traffic on restricted blocks of Merrimac Street.

#### Police Protection

We will provide police traffic supplies as requested and will provide ordinary police services to all citizens using the scheduled personnel.

Crowd Control - This function involving participants is believed to be in excess of 500 persons. The application identifies that extra police protection may be required for events with participants in excess of 50. The recommendation for this event is for one certified police officer for every 500 persons expected to attend, with a minimum of 1 police officer on the grounds being required.

Parking - Parking will take place on the available streets which are not to be closed and we do not expect any issues.

Emergency Vehicle Access - Emergency vehicle access will not be restricted.

#### Recommendation

It is my recommendation to the Dodgeville Common Council to approve a street use permit with the recommended restrictions. The applicant has agreed to comply with provisions of Ordinance #1296 at the point of application.
