City of Dodgeville Licensing Checks 2026

## INTRODUCTION

On 05-27-2026, and 05-28-2026, I, Chief Brandon Wilhelm conducted licensing compliance checks at all establishments with Alcohol Licenses, Cigarette/Tobacco/Vape Licenses, and Dance licenses in the City of Dodgeville. I also conducted an exterior premises check of three mobile home parks within the City of Dodgeville.

The following report with recommendations will be submitted at the June 2nd, 2026 City of Dodgeville Common Council Meeting pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Dodgeville Municipal Code.

## NARRATIVE

Checks on these dates consisted of the following:

Alcohol Beverage Licenses (License displayed in frame with transparent front, license corresponds to retail products, licensed person/agent on premises, alcohol stored properly, alcohol appears unadulterated and in original container, signage prohibiting underage sale)

Cigarette License (License displayed in frame with transparent front, products stored with inability to access by youth, sign prohibiting underage sales, cigarettes in original container)

Dance (License Posted on premises, Licensee confirmed or was provided with ordinance)

Mobile Home (Ordinance compliance checks especially related to junk/abandoned vehicles)

Note: Stores selling THC Products pursuant to the 2018 farm Bill were also provided written notice in April and/or verbal notice on these dates regarding the updated City of Dodgeville ordinance for restriction of sales to under 21.
