

Street Use Permit Application

Food Trucks/Town Square

Event Date(s): July 16th (430pm-830pm) and July 18th (4:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.)

Public Safety Impact

The use of mapped streets for this event causes few issues of concern for Public Safety, due to the precautions listed throughout the application and the location of event. Pedestrians will be walking across N. Iowa St. between the food trucks and the town Square event. Pedestrian safety is a potential concern but crosswalk flags are available and pedestrians are expected to use sound judgement when crossing.

Traffic Movement

No traffic impact will be associated with this event.

Police Protection

This event will not require police traffic control and/or presence. Presence will be variable by on-duty Officers throughout the duration of the event.

Crowd Control

This function involving participants is of no concern given the estimated crowd at this time.

State Highway Closure

This regular application does not include State Highway Use.

Parking

Parking will not be permitted at event location (100 block W. Merrimac). This eliminates 4-6 parking spots on W. Merrimac St. Parking will take place on the adjacent streets and we do not expect any issues. Four spots were requested in the permit but the two additional spots on the South side of the street may be impacted.

**It is requested that the Food trucks do not utilize the space closest to the intersection of Iowa St. to allow for increased vision for vehicles turning North or South onto Iowa St. from W. Merrimac St.

Emergency Vehicle Access

Emergency vehicle access will not be impacted.

Recommendation

It is my recommendation to the Dodgeville Common Council to approve a street use permit based on the recommendations contained herein.
