The Dodgeville Public Library is seeking an outgoing and enthusiastic Community Outreach Coordinator. This person develops and maintains partnerships with community organizations, educational institutions, healthcare providers, employers, and workforce development agencies to identify community needs and connect residents with library resources and services. This person will also help expand the library's role as a community hub by coordinating outreach activities and programs that support health and wellness, workforce development, continuing education, digital literacy, and lifelong learning. The Community Outreach Coordinator promotes awareness and use of library services, assists patrons with technology and information needs, and provides excellent customer service to individuals of all ages and backgrounds.

Pay range \$18 - \$22 per hour, depending on experience. This position is part-time, non-exempt (hourly), 20 hours per week including some weekend and evening shifts. The position includes prorated benefits in accordance with City and Library personnel policies, including health, dental, vision, and paid time off.

Requirements include a Bachelor's degree, valid driver's license, and reliable transportation. Previous experience in management and customer service is desired; previous experience in libraries is preferred.
