Public Safety Impact- The use of mapped streets for this event causes little or no issues of concern for Public Safety, due to the precautions listed throughout the application and the location of concrete barriers at potential entry and egress points.

Traffic Movement- Parking will not be permitted at event location (100 block E. Merrimac). Travel will not be open to vehicular traffic in the 100 block of E. Merrimac St. Other adjacent streets should not be impacted. No specified detour is necessary. Vehicles normally travelling on E. Merrimac St. are still able to use E. division or E. Chapel St. to return to their route via N. Union St.

Police Protection- This event will not require police traffic control and/or presence. Presence will be variable by on-duty Officers throughout the duration of the event.

Crowd Control- This function involving participants is of no concern given the estimated crowd at this time. Constant evaluation throughout the week will be provided to determine if crowd size or acts justify a need for on-site presence.

State Highway Closure- This regular application does include State Highway Use. Road closure authorization has been received for E. Merrimac St.

Parking- Parking will take place on the adjacent streets and we do not expect any issues.

Emergency Vehicle Access- Emergency vehicle access will not be available in the 100 block of E. Merrimac St. Access to adjacent private property may be slightly impacted by the need of first responders to use entry points at the East or West side of the events to access certain entries to apartments and/or private buildings. Barriers placed on the West side of the event are to be placed in manner that an ambulance is still able to park parralel with N. Iowa St and access the event and other areas as needed. Per Ambluance Chief Cushman there are no other concerns.

Recommendation: It is my recommendation to the Dodgeville Common Council to approve a street use permit as anticipated.
