Public Safety Impact- The use of mapped streets for this event causes moderate concern for Public Safety, due to

event size and traffic movement. As part of the approval process it is the recommendation of Chief of Police, Brandon Wilhelm, that an Emergency Operations and Response plan be created for this event in partnership with EMS, Fire, and event staff, prior to the date of the event.

Parking will co-exist with thru traffic except on parade and detour route.

Travel Open to vehicular traffic except where detoured. Detour route available for Hwy 23.

Access by Businesses/Residents Open to vehicular traffic.

Police Protection- We will provide police traffic control and supplies, permitting availability, as indicated in the application and will provide ordinary police services to all citizens using the scheduled personnel.

Crowd Control- This function involving participants is of no concern given the estimated crowd.

State Highway Closure- This regular application does include State Highway Use. Road closure authorization has been received. The alternate route does not include a State Highway Closure.

Parking- Parking will take place on tadjacent available streets and we do not expect any issues.

Emergency Vehicle Access- Emergency vehicle access at the beginning point, throughout the route and access to private property is within the guidelines of the ordinance. Access to some areas may be slightly delayed by parade floats. Access of outside agencies ambulance services responding to the hospital may also provide slight delays of 1-2 minutes.

Recommendation: It is my recommendation to the Dodgeville Common Council to approve a street use permit as anticipated with a requirement that an emergency operations plan be created with Law Enforcement, Fire and EMS input in conjunction with event staff, prior to the event date.
