<p>Street Use Permit Application -Dodge Fest</p> <p>Recommendations by: Chief of Police Brandon E. Wilhelm</p> <p>Event Date is: 08-03-2024 at 0700 hours through 08-04-2024 through 00:00 hours.</p> <p>Public Safety Impact- The use of mapped streets for this event causes moderate issues of concern for Public Safety, primarily related to traffic movement, entry and egress points for first responders, and crowd size. As part of the approval process it is the recommendation of Chief of Police Brandon Wilhelm, that an Emergency Operations and Response plan be created for this event in partnership with EMS, Fire, and event staff, prior to the date of the event.</p> <p>Traffic Movement- Parking will not be permitted on some streets designated in the application (100 block W. Merrimac,, 100 Block of W. Chapel and 200 block of N. Main St.). Travel will not be open to vehicular traffic on these streets as well. Other adjacent streets should not be impacted. No specified detour is necessary. Barricades will be placed to prevent access to the streets. Vehicles normally travelling on E. Merrimac St. and E. Chapel St. are still able to use other routes to return to their designated route.</p> <p>Police Protection- This event will require police presence. Presence will be variable based on the completion of the Emergency Operations plan. Certain times of the event may require additional officers than other times. Evaluation will be given to preceding years events to assist with determination of expected Officer involvement. Officers from outside agencies may be utilized to ensure adequate staffing.</p> <p>Crowd Control- This function involving participants is of moderate concern given the estimated crowd at this time. Constant evaluation throughout the event will be provided by on scene law enforcement to determine necessary crowd control measures.</p> <p>State Highway Closure- This regular application does include State Highway Use. Road closure authorization has been received for E. Merrimac St., E. Chapel St. and N. Main St.</p> <p>Parking- Parking will take place on the adjacent streets and we do not expect any issues.</p> <p>Emergency Vehicle Access- Emergency vehicle access will not be available into the Courthouse parking lot</p>

based on crowd size, barricades and other materials. Adjacent streets will have access based on the removal of barricades as necessary. Access to adjacent private property/residences may be slightly impacted by crowd size, barricades, etc.

Recommendation: It is my recommendation to the Dodgeville Common Council to approve a street use permit as anticipated with a requirement that an emergency operations plan be created with Law Enforcement, Fire and EMS input in conjunction with event staff, prior to the event date.
