10	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the City of Douglas wishes to approve and authorize the purchase pursuant to Article I, Section 3 (A) of the City Charter and the Mayor and Council is empowered to acquire real property for

14	<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED</b> by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona,

16	<b>Section 1</b> . The purchase of the property for an amount of \$560,000 is hereby approved.	

Section 2. The Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions, in a substantially similar form to that attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby approved, and the Mayor, the City Manager, and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and execute all necessary documents to consummate the purchase of the Property.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after final approval and adoption by the Mayor and Council.

Section 4. Severability. If any chapter, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
