6	INCH WATERLINE FROM AIRPORT ROAD TO THE 5 MILLION GALLON RESERVOIR LOCATED IN COCHISE
7	COUNTY, ARIZONA.
9	WHEREAS, the City of Douglas has obtained a grant from the Water Infrastructure Water Authority (WIFA) for the purpose of rehabilitating the 5-million-gallon water reservoir and 16 inch water main to the reservoir; and
10	WHEREAS, the contract with Kimley Horn and Associates will provide bidding document to install a second parallel 16-inch water line from Airport Road to the 5 MG reservoir; and
12	WHEREAS , the WIFA grant has special provisions for its funds to be used for only planning and design, and must be spent prior to June 2026; and
13	WHEREAS, the water line and reservoir are over 60 years old and subject to failure and causing major hardship for the City of Douglas water supply system;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:
16 17	Section 1. Approve contract with Kimley Horn and Associates, Inc. for the design of a new waterline as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, is in the best interest of the City of Douglas.
18	Section 2. The City Manager, and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the contract and any related documents necessary to consummate the transaction for and on behalf of the City of Douglas.
19	Section 3. The officers of the City Council and the City of Douglas are hereby authorized and directed to fulfill all obligations under the terms of the Scope of Work.
