SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION NO. 21-1471**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, AUTHORIZING the Execution of a SERVICE AGREEMENT RENEWAL between the CITY OF DOUGLAS and the SOUTHEASTERN ARIZONA GOVERNMENTS ORGANIZATION (**SEAGO**) in the amount of \$35,000 to be used in the TRANSIT PROGRAM to maintain services for the elderly and disabled individuals in the City of Douglas and surrounding community.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Transit Division applied for and received a subaward agreement from SEAGO Area Agency on Aging to provide free transit services to eligible elderly and disabled riders.

BACKGROUND:

The City contracts with SEAGO to administer transit services to elderly and disabled passengers. Under this contract, SEAGO provides local matching funds to offset the overall cost of the Douglas Rides Transit program.

DISCUSSION:

Staff recommends acceptance of the subaward agreement that provides free transit services to eligible elderly and disabled riders.
