#### To Whom It May Concern:

This is a revised bid package to amend our original bid dated 8/31/22 to clarify the well casing installation procedures. Our firm is very interested in this project. We feel we have the necessary experience, equipment, and manpower to complete the project per the specifications. Our bid is assuming any discharge fluid to be discharged within 50 feet or less from the well head. Our price is assuming the total time to install the liner casing and bail the existing fill in the well while advancing the liner casing is 20 hours. If the time exceeds these hours, then our rate will be per additional hour at the Standby Time at a rate of \$500.00 per hour. We will communicate this time and duration with the City and/or Engineer and will not proceed beyond the based bid fee without authorization. Our price assumes no liquidated damages apply to the project. Due to the current condition of the existing well, KP Ventures will make a good faith effort to complete the project per the specification but we make no guarantee that the slip-line casing and/or filter pack will reach the targeted depth of 495 feet and shall be waived of any liability associated with complications due to the existing casing condition. 
