EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Douglas Police Department has been selected to receive grant funding from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) for Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Enforcement and related materials and supplies (bike helmets) in the amount of \$7,427.00.

BACKGROUND:

The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety solicited proposals for consideration under the Federal 402-PS Plan. Sgt. David Acosta prepared a proposal for Personnel Overtime (including ERE's), Materials and Supplies to enhance the Department's efforts to focus on specific traffic related concerns with regards to pedestrian and bicycle safety.

We have previously received grant funds from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety for DUI and Selective Traffic Enforcement which has served to increase the number of DUI arrests and raise traffic safety awareness within the City and surrounding areas.

DISCUSSION:

The grant period runs from 10/1/2022 through 9/30/2023. Total anticipated award amount is \$7,427.00.
