**SUBJECT:** **RESOLUTION NO. 22-1490**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AUTHORIZING** the CITY OF DOUGLAS to **ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING** and ENTER into a SUBGRANTEE AGREEMENT with the **STATE OF ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY and MILITARY AFFAIRS** for a REIMBURSABLE GRANT FUND allocation in the amount of \$168,052 for EQUIPMENT under the BORDER SECURITY Grant Program.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs selected the Department to receive \$168,052 in funding under the Border Security Fund Grant Program – Border Related Crimes, Prosecution and Imprisonment. The performance period for this grant cycle is July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2026.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Department was selected to receive the following equipment under the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs grant:

5-Year Lease Program for Body Worn Cameras.

The Body Worn Camera (BWC) program will allow us to equip each of the 34 sworn officers plus 2 spares to include associated hardware, software, licensing, evidence storage/redaction; with replacement cameras and docking stations provided at year 3 and year 5. BWC's will capture the activities, actions, and admissions of persons involved with drug trafficking and other border-related crimes and enhance the County Attorney's ability to prosecute those crimes while also enhancing the Federal prosecutor's ability to prosecute crimes associated with human trafficking and illegal immigration through established collaboration with our federal partners.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Initial costs for 5-year lease which staff recommends to be paid in full in a one-lump payment. Funding approved for this project in the CIP to be reallocated to meet other needs at PD.
