**SUBJECT:** **RESOLUTION 25-1705**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AUTHORIZING** the Execution of an **INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT** between the City of Douglas and the **SOUTHEASTERN ARIZONA GOVERNMENTS ORGANIZATION (SEAGO)** to provide **TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE** for Davis-Bacon Labor Standards requirements for the SR-80 West Utilities Expansion Project.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The city has issued a contract award to KE&G to start on Phase 1 of the West Douglas Utilities Expansion Project that extends water, sewer and broadband conduit from the city limits to Cochise College. SEAGO offers their technical assistance to review Davis-Bacon Labor Standards compliance as required by the ARPA grant agreement.

**BACKGROUND:**

SEAGO has certified staff that will assist the city with Davis-Bacon Wages compliance for this project. They have assisted the city in the past including the Well 18 drilling contract. SEAGO will ensure that KE&G and its subcontractors follow all Davis-Bacon wage requirements in accordance to federal regulations. They will review payroll reports to ensure full compliance and report to the city with any issues. Compensation for this agreement that will be run for a six month period is expected to be \$10,543.

**DISCUSSION:**

Staff recommend the IGA to be approved for SEAGO to provide technical assistance for Davis-Bacon wage compliance as required by federal grant guidelines.
