RESOLUTION NO. 25-1707

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CHANGE ORDER TO THE PACE ENGINEERING CONTRACT FOR A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING REPORT – EFFLUENT STUDY AT THE WASTEWATER PLANT ADDING SCOPE OF WORK CONSISTING OF A 30% DESIGN OF THE RECOMMENDED ALTERNATIVE FOR REUSE OF THE EFFLUENT DISCHARGE LOCATED IN COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA.

WHEREAS, the City of Douglas has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the Water Infrastructure Finance Authority (WIFA) for preliminary engineering work on a critical infrastructure project; and

WHEREAS, the city has committed a 25% local match in the amount of \$50,000 as part of the grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, the current contract with PACE Engineers does not include 30% design, and expanding the scope to include this design work will allow the city to fully utilize the WIFA grant funds and avoid deobligating any unused fund; and

WHEREAS, incorporating 30% design will provide detailed project deliverables, including preliminary plans and cost estimates, which will better position the city for future funding and implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. The change order to the contract with PACE Engineers to amend the scope of work to include 30% design is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are authorized to execute the change order and any related documents necessary to implement this resolution.

Section 3. The city agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and grant conditions.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
