SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION NO. 25-1702**, a Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona, **AUTHORIZING** the City of Douglas to accept **GRANT FUNDING** and enter into a **GRANT AGREEMENT** with the **DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE** – COPS Office for a reimbursable grant fund allocation in the amount of **\$83,531** for accreditation.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City of Douglas has been awarded a grant from the Department of Justice – Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) to support the police department’s efforts in seeking first time accreditation through the State of Arizona. The project period for this funding is 10/1/2025 to 9/30/2027.

BACKGROUND:

The police department, through our Grants Coordinator – Daritza Villalobos - applied for this grant on 6/18/2025 for the opportunity to enhance the department’s ability to meet or exceed a number of accreditation standards – primarily in Property & Evidence and software that supports the project management of the accreditation process. This grant aligns with the city’s strategic goals and supports ongoing efforts by the police department in achieving accredited status.

DISCUSSION:

The total award amount is \$83,531, with no required match. Staff recommend approval.
