| 10             | <b>WHEREAS</b> , the City Manager recommends a reorganization adding two new positions for FY 22/23 Budget, reclassifying a few positions, and eliminating six positions; and   |

Recent attrition and analysis of needs will be better addressed through a reorganization. Through this reorganization, we are moving positions within departments, creating new divisions within departments, removing six positions from the organization, and adding two. These changes are needed to move forward efficiently in streetspublic works, development services, communications, and tourism; and |

| 22             | <b>Section 2.</b> The Public Works department requires the following actions for this reorganization:   |

Split the Construction Division into two; 1) Streets (streets, curbing, sidewalks, street lights and traffic lights) and 2) Facilities & Airport (facilities maintenance, construction activities and airport maintenance). Each division will have a supervisor. The current Construction Supervisor (range 28) will be reclassified to Facilities & Airport Supervisor (range 28) and create a new Streets Supervisor position (range 28).

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
